PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program offers students the opportunity to visit India while learning about accounting, auditing, and accounting information systems (AIS) in a global context. As the world's largest democracy with a booming economy, India is a unique country that is becoming a major force in the world economy. Students can experience Indian culture while learning about International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) and the issues pertaining to auditing and systems for multinational corporations. The specifics are:

- * Financial Reporting—IFRS in India, standard setting & enforcement, and complexity of reporting using different GAAP standards
- * Auditing—US-based vs. Indian-outsourced audit functions, auditing standards, and procedures in India
- * AIS—importance to audit, reporting, and internal control of multinational companies

Expected site visits include the BIG 4 accounting firms, international businesses, the Bombay Stock Exchange, and cultural sites including the Taj Mahal. The program also offers visits with representatives of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, the Securities and Exchange Board, and the Chamber of Commerce in Mumbai, New Delhi or Bangalore.

Jackie Reck is the James E. Rooks Distinguished Professor in the School of Accountancy. Her interests are primarily financial and government-nonprofit accounting.
